# Service Officer Responsibilities

- 1. Open 24 hours a day 365 days a year (Yes, we work ALL Holidays)
- 2. Answer Business lines for all police business (one number for all)
- 3. Dispatch calls for service over the radio for field units
- 4. Monitor outside agencies' frequencies and advise PVE units in an event that pursuits or crime suspects are headed into our city
- 911 for both police and medical transfers to LA County Fire and monitor call in case PD needs to respond- ability to contact station 2 directly – Saving time from LA Dispatch
- 6. Receive audible/panic alarm calls from businesses and residences
- 7. Receive/transfer calls from/to oth er agencies
- 8. Monitor ALPR and Security Cameras at City Halls/PD and MC Fountain
- 9. Send Nixle Alerts to residents
- 10. Process Records, Property (lost and found, etc.)
- 11.Assist Sworn officers with female searches in the field if no female sworn officer is on duty





## PVE CITY JAIL





- Adults arrested are held up to 96 hours.
- All arrestees are booked:
  - Screening/classification for housing,
  - Fingerprinted
  - Photographed
  - Housed
  - Fed
  - Monitored
- Arrestees are then released, or booked into County Jail or transported to Court.
- Why do we need a jail in PVE?

#### MONTHLY PVEPD ARRESTS 2015-2017



- 1 Arrest per day, on average

















































































































### STOP SIGN ENFORCEMENT


