KEEPING OUR PVE POLICE

Keeping our PVE Police Department is the best way to ensure the safety of our community and maintain local control. While neighboring cities struggle with unsolved crimes, our local PVE Police Department stands as a model of community policing.

KEEPING OUR PVE POLICE MEANS:

- We keep a police force that is dedicated to the safety of our residents.
- We keep our program of community policing which ensures a culture of safety, service, and respect for civil rights.
- We keep local control of our budget rather than have costs dictated to us by the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department as it faces hundreds of millions in budget cuts.

LOCAL CONTROL OF DEVELOPMENT

I have consistently opposed state mandates that imperil our ability to protect views, setback requirements, and the single-family character of our neighborhoods. If elected, I would be the only member of our City Council with prior experience on the Planning Commission.

RETAINING LOCAL CONTROL OF DEVELOPMENT MEANS:

- We continue to protect our views, our privacy, and the character of our neighborhoods.
- We retain single-family zoning which is central to the character of our city and serves to reduce traffic, improve parking availability, and promote fire safety.
- We decide on policies that are appropriate for our neighborhoods without having to apply a one-size-fits-all solution.
